

Additional criteria for candidates applying to the Doctoral School in the Humanities, special program: CHAPTER research grant

Basic Requirements:

- Planned project correlates with research objectives of the CHAPTER project (The successful candidate will develop a dissertation (PhD) which correlates with research objectives of the CHAPTER project)
- Excellent MA degree in Cultural Anthropology, Ethnology, History, Cultural Studies, Museum Studies, Heritage Studies, Memory Studies, or comparable disciplines.
- Experience with qualitative research and/or fieldwork
- · Willingness to work in an international team
- For non-native speakers: Very good English skills (official certificate of C1 level or a written proof of English proficiency from a current academic advisor)
- For non-native speakers: Very good Polish skills (official certificate of C1 level or a written proof of English proficiency from a current academic advisor)

Advantageous qualifications are:

- Previous experience with ethnographic research
- Previous experience in the area of education (especially working with young people) and/or museum visitor studies
- Previous experience and strong interest in the field of digital media (both as research field and regarding practical skills: IT-knowledge, software skills, content management, etc.)
- Previous experience in international research projects, conferences, workshops
- For non-native speakers: Excellent English skills (official certificate of C2 level)
- For non-native speakers: Excellent Polish skills (official certificate of C2 level)
