

Admission requirements within the project “How do we love? Romantic love and cultural capital among urban middle class in Indian metropolises” (**Polish National Science Centre grant, OPUS 19 scheme, no. 2020/37/B/HS3/04074, principal investigator: Anna Romanowicz, Ph.D.**).

1. Resolution of the Jagiellonian University Senate no. 55/VI/2020, with respect to admission requirements to the Doctoral School in the Humanities in the academic year of 2020/2021 (of 24th June 2020) and the guidelines of the Polish National Centre, apply for this admission process.
2. Minimum admission requirements within the project “How do we love? Romantic love and cultural capital among urban middle class in Indian metropolises”:
  - a. the topic of the thesis must be closely related to the project’s research tasks;
  - b. strong command of the English language;
  - c. the candidate has to present:
    - an interest in the project’s topic and research in India or other South Asian countries;
    - knowledge of cultural realities of this region;
    - knowledge of research ethics (especially with regard to the research in postcolonial countries).
3. Additional assets, taken into consideration in the admission process:
  - a. knowledge/education in socio-cultural anthropology and/or in literature studies;
  - b. an experience in discourse analysis;
  - c. knowledge of vernacular languages (Hindi and/or Marathi);
  - d. an academic experience and/or willingness for academic development, especially to publish in peer-reviewed academic journals, presentations at the conferences and dissemination of research results in non-academic venues.
