

## **INFORMATION ON THE REPORT ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE INDIVIDUAL RESEARCH PLAN**

- A. The evaluation concerns the results of the implementation of the individual research plan;
- B. Doctoral Students shall submit the following documents for evaluation:
  - 1. The final, approved version of the individual research plan;
  - 2. Report on the implementation of the individual research plan – evaluated by the Doctoral Committee or Evaluation Team and approved by the Head of the Program,
  - 3. Annex in the form of a result/results of research work together with the opinion of the Supervisor/Supervisors on the scientific quality of the results presented.

An annex shall be regarded as a portfolio (set of research results) documenting the progress of a Doctoral Student's research. The portfolio should include materials that allow to evaluate the Doctoral Student's results to date in the implementation of the individual research plan and may include: one or two chapters of the doctoral dissertation (and in the case of dissertations in the form of a monographic collection of articles – at least one article with a confirmation of acceptance from a journal included in the ministerial list or from the editor of a joint publication), a (preliminary) database prepared for analysis, documentation of other empirical data collected for analysis as well as other relevant materials proving progress in the implementation of the individual research plan together with the supervisor's opinion on the scientific quality of the results submitted for evaluation by the Doctoral Student. Heads of Programs shall provide information on the particular forms of presenting results of the implementation of individual research plans.
