

Admission Criteria

“Space technologies, resources and ‘multi-planetary’ communities:
Space exploration and the imaginaries of living in a climate-changing world”

1. The general rules and evaluation criteria relevant to this competition are set out in the resolution of the University’s Senate no 55/VI/2020 of 24 June 2020 regarding admission requirements to the Doctoral School in the Humanities at Jagiellonian University in the academic year 2021/2022 as well as the guidelines of the National Science Centre.
2. All applicants should:
 - a. hold or be close to completion of an MA degree (or equivalent) in social anthropology or another discipline in the humanities or social sciences (such as but not limited to history, philosophy, sociology, politics, international relations, human geography);
 - b. submit a competitive research proposal for a doctoral project in the area of space exploration. The aims and scope of the proposed research should be compatible with the goals of the project.
3. Desirable criteria:
 - a. experience in conducting ethnographic research,
 - b. excellent English language skills in speaking and writing,
 - c. demonstrated ability to work as part of a team and to contribute to the achievement of team goals.
