

Nazwa jednostki: Jagiellonian University – Kraków

Nazwa stanowiska: PhD candidate in the NCN SONATA BIS 10 project “Travel and Mobility in Hellenistic and Early Roman Palestine” and simultaneously a PhD student of the Doctoral School in the Humanities of Jagiellonian University

Wymagania:

1. Candidate will be required to have an MA in a field relevant to the project (e.g., history, theology, philology, or cultural studies) effective on March 1, 2022;
2. Candidate should have a competence in Biblical Greek or Hebrew, the knowledge of Greek is given priority, if the successful candidate does not have any knowledge of one of the required languages, he/she will be required to undergo intensive training during the first two years of the studies. The PhD student will also be expected to learn Biblical Aramaic during the PhD studies;
3. Candidate should have a good knowledge of English.

Opis zadań:

The main responsibility of the Candidate is to analyze the Septuagint translation of the Hebrew Bible with regard to travel and mobility. The results of this analysis should be prepared as a monograph to be published in an internationally recognized publishing house. The Candidate will also continuously take part in the proceedings of the team, especially by conducting three one-month scientific consultations abroad; participating in five one-month archaeological seasons in Israel, the Palestinian Authorities, and Jordan over the entire course of the project; contributing to the international workshop held at Jagiellonian University; and drafting one chapter for the final monograph of the project.

Warunki zatrudnienia:

The Candidate is required to pursue the four-year plan for finishing the Doctoral School. The budget for the stipend is 5,000 PLN (gross, monthly, for 48 months in total). The Candidate will receive additional resources for a laptop, two international conference trips, English proofreading of the PhD manuscript, participation in five team fieldworks, three individual one-month research visits abroad (to the UK, the Netherlands, and Germany), and Bible study software.
