

**Research tasks** for doctoral candidate within research project NCN OPUS 22 project *After Climate Crisis. Non-Scalable Survival Strategies in Speculative Fabulations of the Last Two Decades* (PI: dr hab. Mateusz Borowski, prof. UJ):

- 1. Preparation and defense of doctoral dissertation tightly connected with the major research tasks of the NCN OPUS 22 project *After Climate Crisis. Non-Scalable Survival Strategies in Speculative Fabulations of the Last Two Decades*
- 2. Participation in workshops, seminars and working groups within the framework of the project
- 3. Publication of three scholarly articles in Polish or English in peer-reviewed academic journals.
- 4. Preparation of promotional materials (the scope of which will be consulted with PI of the project)

Upon agreement with the candidate the PI may appoint them additional research task. Part of the tasks will be carried out individually, however all of them will require cooperation with the entire team involved in the project.

## **Conditions of participation in the project:**

- 1. The budget for the stipend is 5,000 PLN (gross, monthly, for 48 months in total) within the framework of four-year Interdisciplinary and Cross-Domain Doctoral Program in the Doctoral School in the Humanities at Jagiellonian University.
- Upon agreement with PI the doctoral candidate may receive full or partial coverage of funds for participation in domestic and international conferences, purchase of academic books necessary for carrying out research tasks, proofreading, office supplies and the cost of Open Access publications.
- 3. The doctoral candidate may apply for other funds offered by the Doctoral School in Humanities at Jagiellonian University.
